



Jennifer & Barry, part 14

December, 2004 – January, 2005

Just a few more weeks and we will be finished! In early December, Barry covered the floor & walls of the crawlspace with 6 ml plastic. Then the HVAC unit and ductwork was installed. We purchased a 2.5-ton Goodman packaged unit and used the crawlspace as the return plenum. The system works wonderfully!

I finished hanging sheetrock on the walls, and Barry finished mudding the sheetrock in the livingroom, kitchen, hallway and bathroom. During Christmas break I spent three days painting so Barry could start on the flooring. We chose to install cabinet-grade birch plywood for the flooring and Barry positioned them in a grid-like pattern. He used stainless steel screws and put three coats of non-yellowing moisture cure polyurethane on the plywood. The floors are beautiful.

This past weekend, I finished assembling the stainless steel kitchen cabinets. This week, Barry will be finishing the plumbing, mudding the bedroom walls and hopefully finding some time to relax on the sofa.
